Body analysis:

Observing muscular, skeletal or postural imbalance. Assessing the back, the neck, shoulders, knees, etc. The importance of muscles and joints in balance. How to check effectiveness of treatments.

Articular rotations:

Deciding the best direction, their effect

Correct posture for effortless rotations.

Rotations at floor level (futon) and

on a massage table.

Toes, ankles, hips, wrists, shoulders, elbows and finger rotations.
